Father Kevin's thought for Lent: Week 2

In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus takes Peter, James and John to a mountain top. Why a mountain top? Well, it's a place where God often spoke to people in scripture and He still does speak but in other quiet places of our busy world. For these disciples Jesus leads them away from the day to day of life so that they can see, hear, and experience the presence and power of God. As an experience, it is profound. One that can be summed up as a perfect moment, a moment, that perhaps we've experienced when feeling God not only in the beauty and silence of our created world but in the love of others. This was such a moment for Peter, James, and John. Like all perfect moments they want to hold onto it as expressed by Peter, but like all perfect moments, it can't last forever. Jesus tells them to remember the moment something they will need down the road, off the mountain, in the day to day of life. So what can we take from this Gospel story? The first is the need to take time out from the world to pray or simply be quiet, even if it is only for 10 minutes. There is always a good chance God will speak to you even if the message is simply to trust that He is with you. The second is to call to mind, to remember perfect moments in your life when you were deeply aware of your blessings or that God was with you and those you love. Those were the moments when something awesome about life, relationships, or the created world said something to you that you have never forgotten. Those moments never stop reminding us of God and encouraging or helping us on the days when things are not so great, and we could all use a lot of that, encouragement and help.
