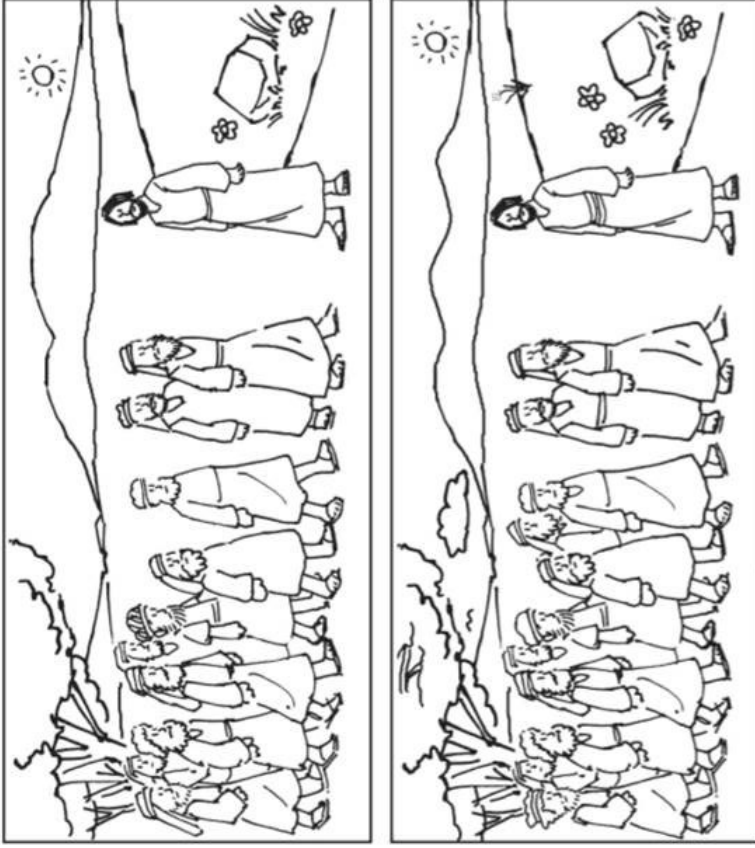

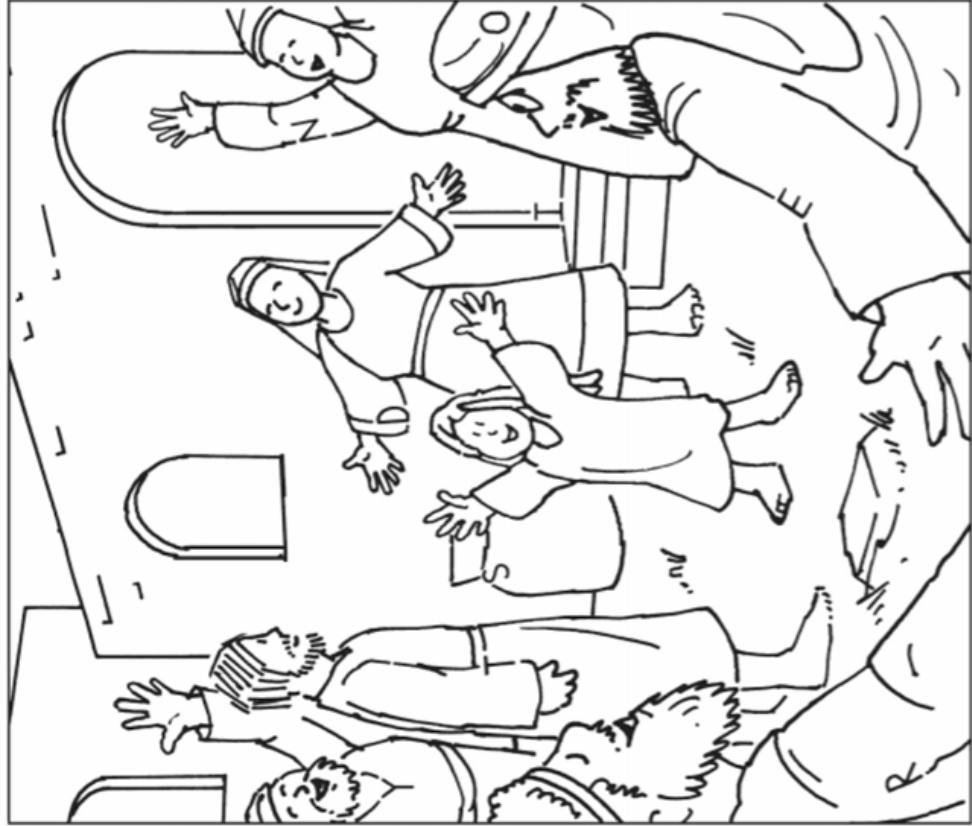

This all took place in the region of Tyre and Sidon

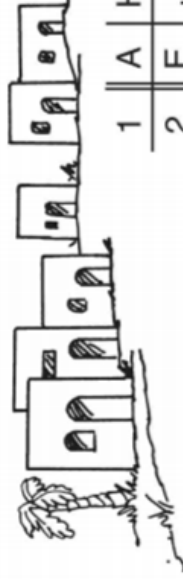

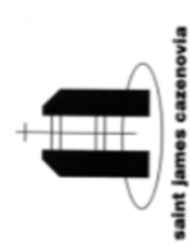
