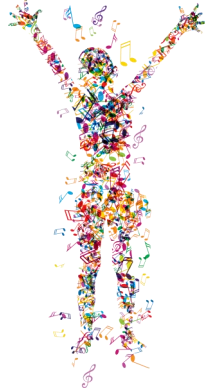
**Attentiveness to God in Daily Life**

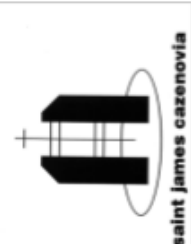

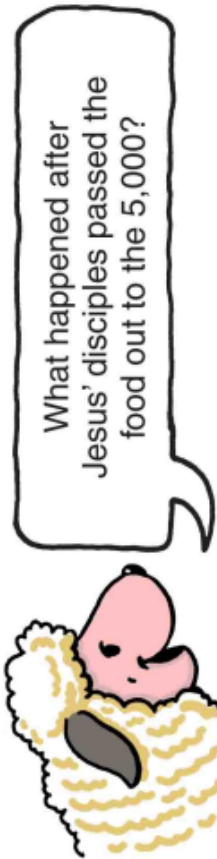

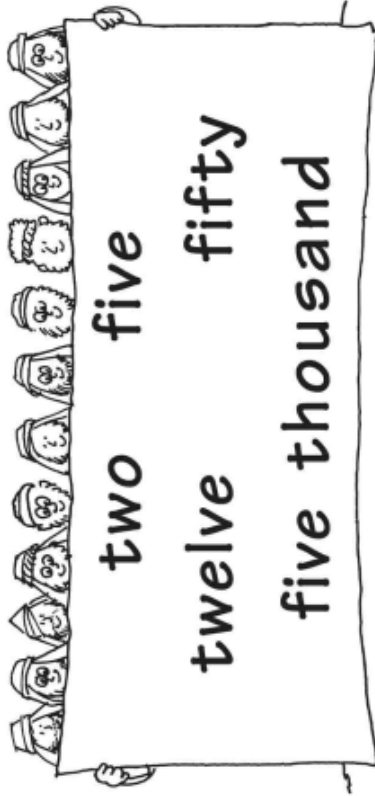
